



PDF 209 Rain Forest Flower Scarf

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Materials

Crochet Hooks Size J and 11 MM
Sensations Multi Casual Boucle Yarn - Black/Green/Blue
Loop- d- Loop Ribbon Yarn - Fern
LionBrand Wool Ease – Pines

Abbreviations

sl st – slip stitch
ch – chain stitch
sc – single crochet
hdc – half double crochet
dc – double crochet

Instructions

Part 1

Beginning with Wool Ease and **11 mm** crochet hook,
ch 51.

Row 1: sc in 2nd ch from hook and in next 49, ch 1, turn.

Row 2: sl st in front loop of 50 st, ch 1, turn.

Row 3: sl st in top loop of 50 st, ch 1, turn.

Rows 4 – 13: repeat Row 3.

Row 14: sc in 30 st, dc in next 19 st, 3 dc in last st, continue around to work rows on the end.

Row 1: sc in 7 st, ch 1, turn.

Row 2: sc in 4 st, dc in 5 st, ch 2, turn.

Row 3: dc in 5 st, sc in 4.

Fasten off. Weave in ends.

Part 2

Using **Crochet Hook J**, attach boucle to very first row opposite the dc, as shown:



sc in same st, sk st, 5 dc in next st, sk st, * sc in next, sk st, 5 dc in next st, sk st *. Repeat from * to * to the end. 3 sc in last st, continue around to work row across the end.

Row 1: sc in next 11 st, ch 2, turn.

Row 2: hdc in 12 st, ch 3 turn.

Row 3: dc in same st, ch 2, 2 dc in same st * sk 2 st in next st work (dc, ch 2, 2dc) shell completed. Repeat from * 2 more times, ch 3, tun.

Row 4: (work shell in ch 2 sp)4 times, ch 3, turn.

Rows 5 – 12: repeat Row 4.

Row 13: (work shell in ch 2 sp)4 times.

Fasten off. Weave in ends.

Part 3

Working with **11 mm** crochet hook and boucle and ribbon yarn together, attach to scarf to very first row where boucle was attached previously, and work in the opposite direction, sc in each st to the end.

Begin rows across the end of the scarf.

Row 1: ch 5(counts as dc, ch 2), dc in same st, * sk 2 st,(dc, ch 2, dc in same st) V stitch made. Repeat from * 2 more times.

Row 2: ch 5(counts as dc, ch 2), dc in same st, work V st in next 3 V st, cut ribbon leaving a 3 inch tail to weave in, **switch to Crochet Hook J** and continue with boucle only, ch 2 turn.

Row 3: sc in same st and in next 15 st, ch 2 turn.

Row 4: hdc in same st and in next 15 st, ch 2 turn.

Rows 5 – 9: repeat Row 4.

Row 10: hdc in 16 st, ch 3, turn.

Row 11: dc in sp between hdc, ch 1, turn.

Row 12: dc in sp between dc, ch 3, turn.

Rows 13 – 18: repeat Row 12.

Row 19: dc in sp between dc, ch 1, turn.

Row 20: sc in sp between dc, ch 2, sc in next sp across, continuing across.

Fasten off.

Weave in ends.

Flower

Using ribbon yarn and **Crochet Hook J**, ch 3, join to form ring.

Round 1: ch 1, work 7 sc in ring. Join with sl st to 1st ch at beginning of round.

Round 2: (ch9, sl st in same st, sl st in next st)7 times.

Round 3: (work 11 sc in ch 9 loop)7 times. Join with sl st to 1st ch at beginning of round.

With boucle yarn and J hook, ch 10 and fasten off, leaving 6 inch tail. Tie a square knot (make circle and draw one end through, tighten, make another circle and draw the other end through, tighten), attach it to the center of the flower and attach the flower to the scarf.
