



## 215 Easy Unisex Striped Scarf

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### Materials:

Color A: Red Heart Aran Fleck

Color B - stripes: Caron Simply Soft Woodland Heather

Color C – optional stripe: Red Heart Super Saver Aran

Or any medium weight yarn of your choice

Crochet Hook Size K ( or 2 or 3 sizes larger than recommended on yarn)

### Abbreviations

ch – chain stitch

sc – single crochet

hdc – half double crochet

## Changing Color

With the last stitch at the end of the row, pull up the new color, ch 1, bringing the end of the yarn through, and tighten, as shown:



as you crochet the next row, hold the ends down and crochet over them to secure. Here is a link to a free tutorial:

## Instructions

ch 22.

Row 1: hdc in 2nd ch from hook, (sc in next ch, hdc in next ch)10 times, ch 1 turn.

Row 2: sc in hdc (hdc in next sc, sc in next hdc)10 times, ch 1 turn.

Row 3: hdc in sc, (sc in next hdc, hdc in next sc)10 times, ch 1 turn.

Rows 4 – 8: repeat Rows 2 and 3.

Row 9: repeat Row 3, changing to Color B at the end of the row, ch 1, turn.

Row 10: repeat Row 2.

Row 11: repeat Row 3, changing to Color A at the end of the row. Ch 1, turn.

Rows 12 – 15: repeat Rows 2 and 3, changing to Color B at the end of the row.

Rows 16 – 17: repeat Rows 2 and 3, changing to Color A at the end of the row.

Continue repeating Row 2 for even-numbered rows and Row 3 for odd-numbered rows.

Rows 18 – 21: Color A

Rows 22 – 23: Color B.

Rows 24 – 25: Optional Color C, or continue with Color B.

Rows 26 – 27: back to Color B if you used another color.

Rows 28 – 31: Color A.

Rows 32 – 33: Color B.

Rows 34 -37: Color A.

Rows 38 - 39: Color B. Fasten off Color B.

Rows 40 – 93: Color A.

Rows 94 – 95: Color B.

Rows 96 – 99: Color A.  
Rows 100 – 101: Color B.  
Rows 102 – 105: Color A.  
Rows 106 – 107: Color B.  
Rows 108 – 109: Color B or Optional Color C.  
Rows 110 – 111: Color B.  
Rows 112 – 115: Color A.  
Rows 116 – 117: Color B.  
Rows 118 – 121: Color A.  
Rows 122 – 123: Color B.  
Rows 124 – 132: Color A.

Fasten off.

### **Optional Fringe**

Cut 42 pieces of yarn 8 inches long. Taking 2 at a time, fold in half, pull through end stitch at the end of the scarf from back to front, bring ends through the loop and tighten, as shown:
